The University will not accept completed prequalification questionnaires via FAX, and all prequalification questionnaires submitted must be sent so that they are received by the University on or before **September 21, 2006, 2PM.**

No prequalification questionnaire will be accepted after **September 21, 2006, 2PM.** However, the University reserves, at its sole discretion, the right to request, to receive, and to evaluate supplemental information after the above time and date.

Bidders will be notified by letter, sometime during **late October 2006** whether or not they are prequalified.

All information submitted for prequalification evaluation will be considered official information acquired in confidence, and the University will maintain its confidentiality to the extent permitted by law.

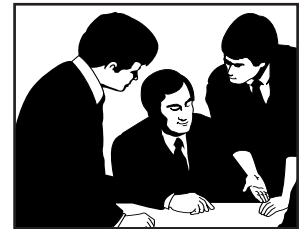
